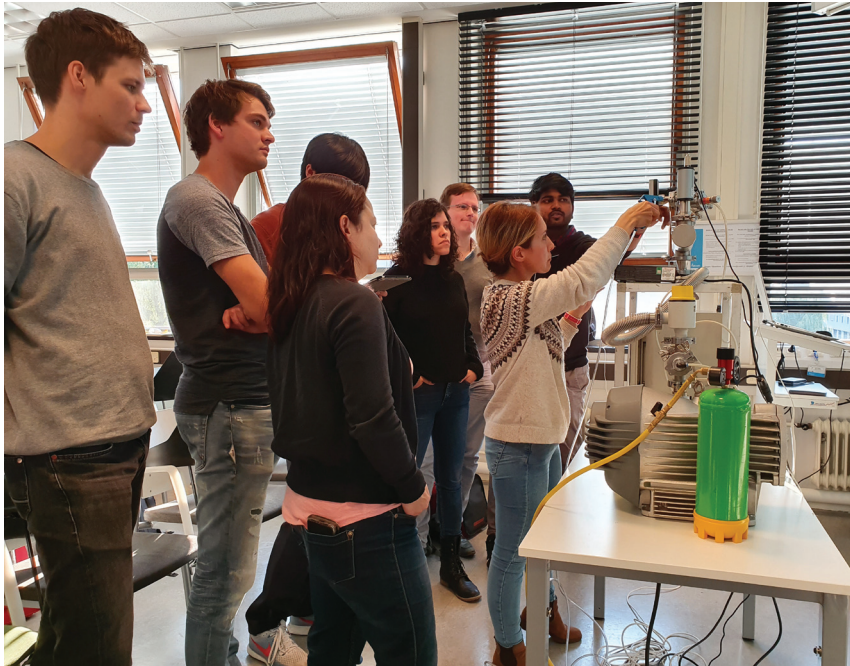


Applied Vacuum Technology training for PhD students and postdocs in 2021

In April or May 2021 the **Applied Vacuum Technology training** will be organised for Master students, PhD students and post-doctoral researchers in Physics and Chemistry. The training is organised under auspices of the NEVAC (Netherlands Vacuum Society)

Goal:

- Develop an understanding of vacuum phenomena
- Get familiar with the operation of vacuum equipment
- Increase skills to define design criteria

If the situation is safe, a live training will be organised at Science Park Amsterdam, otherwise the training will be online. Maximum group size: 20 students

The costs for this advanced training are € 495 pp, including *Vacuum Science and Technology* by Suurmeijer et al, handouts, lunch, drinks
